

## ADDITIONAL FIGURES – CHAPTER 10

### Jurisdiction and grave crimes

Jurisdiction over children (10-13) and young people (14-17)

Grave crimes may be tried in the youth court or sent to the Crown Court for trial.

### Allocation

Generally, all offences tried summarily in youth court.

Exceptions include where a youth *must* be sent to the Crown Court (eg murder) and *may* be sent to the Crown Court (dangerous offender)
